

## **DRB NESDB Travel Award**

This travel award is meant to fully support registration, travel, shared housing, and meals at the New England Society for Developmental Biology (NESDB) conference at the Marine Biological Laboratory in Woods Hole from April 3-5, 2020 for students who present at the meeting. Students will serve as representatives of the Harvard Developmental and Regenerative (DRB) Program to the larger stem cell and developmental biology community.

This application is open to any registered DRB students (DRB degree candidates and affiliated students from BBS, as well as other HMS/HU graduate programs). *Note:* if you are not yet registered as an affiliate of the DRB Program, please complete this form prior to submission.

Students can apply an unlimited number of times in their graduate career, but are eligible to receive the conference award a maximum of *two* times during their tenure in the DRB Program. Priority selection will go to students who are actively engaged in the DRB Program. Students will be notified no later than March 1<sub>st</sub>, with a formal announcement of the 2020 awards at the Annual DRB Retreat on March 30<sub>th</sub>.
